TIIS Achieves Top Results in RAE 2020

We are pleased to announce that the Department of Translation, Interpreting and Intercultural Studies, Hong Kong Baptist University, has achieved outstanding results in the 2020 Research Assessment Exercise (RAE) of the Hong Kong SAR.

34% of our overall performance was rated as “World Leading” (4*), making us the top Unit of Assessment in the Translation category, when judged on percentage of 4* rankings. A further 29% was rated as “Internationally Excellent” (3*).

We are also the only institution to achieve “World Leading” (4*) in both Impact and Environment. The Impact category measures the social, political or cultural impact of our research beyond the academe, while the Environment category assesses the quality and vibrancy of the unit’s research environment.

We will continue to strive to produce research of the highest quality in the years to come. A sincere thanks to everyone who contributed to this great result!
