WEI Liping is a PhD student at the Department of Translation and Intercultural Studies (TIIS) at Hong Kong Baptist University. She holds an M.A. degree from Guangdong University of Foreign Studies, and has previously worked as an in-house interpreter at Huawei before transitioning to a university lecturer in Mainland China. She is also a certified CATTI Level I interpreter and a member of the Translators Association of China. Her research interests are computer-assisted interpreting (CAI) and computer-assisted interpreting training.

Her proposed project aims to identify T&I and other interdisciplinary insights with a focus on technology/AI/new methods that could potentially be leveraged in training simultaneous interpreters; propose a revamped SI training curriculum; and assess the effectiveness and efficiency of this new training proposal in improving SI trainees' performance, compared to current SI training practices. It is hoped that this research endeavor could help improve SI pedagogy and contribute to the evolving discourse on technology-driven interpreter education.
